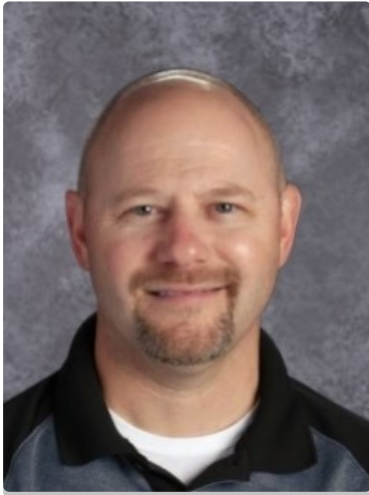

Earning college credits while in high school:

In addition to taking AP courses during high school, students can also take classes through MATC or UW system to earn college credit. The Early College Credit Program and Start College Now Program are great opportunities for students who are interested in starting their post-secondary studies while still in high school and also for those who want to gain skills and knowledge needed to enter the workforce directly after high school graduation. Student applications for classes during the spring 2022 semester must be turned in to Ms. Schoemer to be approved by the board by October 1, 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.

Taher Food Service

Below are some bullet points regarding the services for next year:

- Free pre-packaged breakfasts will be available and distributed at two points of service inside the HS between 8:15-8:30. One will be at the front entrance, the other will be at the rear entrance to the building. Simply take and go.
- Lunch for students will also be available free of charge. Meals include **at least 3** different food groups, one of which must be a serving of fruit or vegetable. There will be numerous delicious choices of entrees and baskets daily.
- A large variety of a la carte items will be available for purchase through student accounts only. No cash will be accepted.
- All students will be required to go through the cashier lines to ensure proper tracking and/or charging. To speed up this process students are required to carry their ID's with them in order to utilize the scan bar for check out.
- Menus will be available on the district's website and the Taher Food 4 Life website and app as usual.
