# Open Art Studio

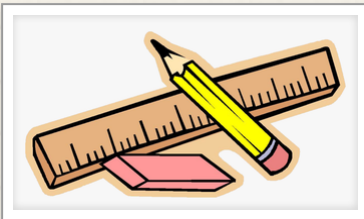


**Every Thursday, starting Thursday, 9/17:**
