Technology Return

In-person students (Grades K-4)

Students in grades K-4 will be returning their district issued iPad and charging cord (KG) or Chromebook and charging cord (1-4) to the library on **Monday, June 7th.** If students were issued a district hotspot, it must also be returned with the iPad or Chromebook.



Virtual Vikings (Grades K-4)

Students in grades K-4 will be returning their district issued iPad and charging cord (KG) or Chromebook and charging cord (1-4) to the school on **Wednesday**, **June 9th from 12:00 to 4:00 and Thursday**, **June 10th from 8:00 to 3:00.** If students were issued a district hotspot, it must also be returned with the iPad or Chromebook. Please clearly label any items being returned with the student's name and grade.

In-person students (5th grade)

5th grade students will be keeping their district assigned Chromebook over the summer this year. All students will be receiving a protective case for their Chromebook before they leave for the summer. This will help protect the Chromebooks over the summer and ensure their Chromebook is ready to use on the first day of the 2021-22 school year. If students were issued a district hotspot, it must be returned to the library on Monday, June 7th.

Virtual students (5th grade)

5th grade students will be keeping their district assigned Chromebook over the summer this year. When students return to in-person school next year, they will receive a protective case for their Chromebook. **If students were issued a district hotspot, it must be returned to the school on Wednesday, June 9th from 12:00 to 4:00 and Thursday, June 10th from 8:00 to 3:00.** Please clearly label any items being returned with the student's name and grade.



Student has had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

NEXT STEPS

- 1. Call your school's attendance line to report your student's absence.
- 2. Fill out the Student COVID-19 Form at stoughton.k12.wi.us under the "COVID-19" tab.
- 3. Contact your health care provider for next steps.

*Symptoms of COVID-19

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or
 Sore throat difficulty breathing
- Fever equal to or greater than 100.4°F
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
 Nausea or vomiting
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Congestion or runny nose
