State of Wisconsin Driver Education age requirements: The student must be 15 years old to enter classroom. The student must be a minimum of 15-1/2 years old to obtain an Instructional Permit from the State of Wisconsin DMV. Students must pass the classroom or the on-line course to be eligible for the Instructional Permit. Once a student turns 18 years old, or their high school class has graduated, they are no longer eligible for this program.

2018-2019 STOUGHTON SCHOOL DISTRICT DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

CESA #2 is assisting Stoughton High School with the Drivers' Education Program. For your convenience, students may attain a Wisconsin driver's license through a program offered by CESA #2, at the Stoughton High Schools' campus, both during the school year and during the summer. Both the classroom classes and Behind the Wheel lessons are taught at Stoughton High School. CESA #2 follows all policies and procedures that are set by the Stoughton High School.

Driver Education is a foundation course, which teaches the theory of responsible driving, defensive driving, and emphasis is placed on the introduction of the proper safety mechanics of safe driving. The course is designed to improve the student's knowledge of traffic safety and to become safe operators of motor vehicles. The course covers all areas of vehicle operation, legal obligations, maintenance, effects of alcohol and other drugs, with a strong emphasis on distractive driving.

PROGRAM COST

Traditional Classroom \$150.00- Driver Education is a foundation course which teaches the theory of responsible driving. Emphasis is placed upon introduction of mechanics of driving, execution of most driving operations, and a thorough understanding of rules of safe driving. We provide 30 hours of classroom instruction.

Students that attend the class without registering with CESA # 2 will be dismissed from class and not receive instruction.

CESA #2 requires information on any special needs that your child might have i.e. hearing impaired, ADD, IEP's, juvenile diabetes, etc. We will do our best to accommodate the needs for your child's success.

Online Class Course \$175.00- The Online Driver Education course offered by CESA #2 provides a unique opportunity for students that have busy schedules to learn critical skills needed to become a safe, low-risk driver. Our program is one of few that meet the National and State Standards for online learning. Your child will have an instructor to work with them throughout the course.

On-line Course Required Textbook: This course is based on the AAA's book, How to Drive. **This book must be purchased** and is not provided through CESA2. How to Drive is offered as a soft-cover book or an e-book. There is a \$50.00 fee for all on-line extensions.

Behind the Wheel \$250.00- This course is for students between the age of 15.5 and 18 who have completed the 30-hour classroom portion, or the online course and need to fulfill the Behind the Wheel requirements for the state of Wisconsin. The Behind the Wheel course includes six hours of in-car training and 6 hours of observation. Your student must successfully complete both the classroom and Behind the Wheel requirements to be eligible for the electronic DMV completion. The DMV electronic completion is required for the student to take the Wisconsin Licensing Driving Skill Test.

A \$22.00 No-Show fee will be imposed for any missed Behind the Wheel Lesson. The fee will be due prior to next lesson.

The Behind the Wheel (BTW) training **MUST** start within 13 months from the end of the classroom. If this does not happen the State of Wisconsin will require the student to take a 10-hour re-fresher course. The Temporary License will expire. We will not renew it until the 10-hour course is completed.

We can offer your student a 10-hour on-line refresher on-line course or he can retake the entire classroom. There is no additional cost for retaking the classroom. Attendance is mandatory. The cost for the on-line re-fresher is \$75.00 plus you will have to purchase an e-book or soft cover text book for an additional \$16.99.

Refunds: No refunds or transfer of registration fees between students will be issued after one year from the date of the original registration. There is a \$50.00 processing fee for all refunds during the one-year period. All service fees for credit card transactions are non-refundable.

There is an additional \$50.00 fee withheld on refunds for all online students. If your student has completed any portion of the online course, we will also withhold a portion of the registration fee for payment to the online instructor's time spent working with your student. The \$16.95 for the online text book is non-refundable.
