## From the Art Room

New to the ceramics and 3D room is a 3D ceramic printer purchased through a grant from Cummins. Advanced Ceramic students generate printable files on a web based app called Potterware. From a g code file, students print their created designs with clay. (Kailani Wolfe, left, demonstrates printing a "G" and trimming. She plans to enter the Google design competition.) ## PhotoShop Planets and Space Assignment

Space: the final frontier. These are the voyages of the 5th hour Computer Art Class. Its half year mission: to explore strange tools, to seek out new styles and new compositions, to boldly go where no one has gone before.

In this assignment, students get introduced to the basics in PhotoShop and create a scene of space that is crafted from photos of texture to make our planets, a customized and warped gradient for our nebula, and customized scatter brushes for the stars. They also learn how to apply layer styles to create the effect of an outer glow on selected objects.

Advanced Art students will have their art show May 20-June 7, 2020. Open House will be May 26, 6-8 PM. Art work will be displayed in the Performing Arts Center Gallery.

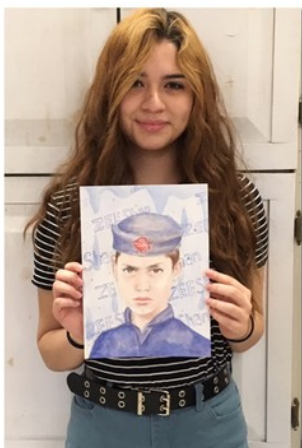


First semester students in advanced art created portraits for children in Pakistan. This semester students will extend goodwill to children in Eastern Europe.

## All Dressed Up

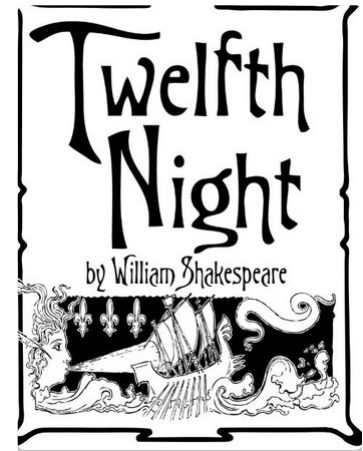

## Spring Play

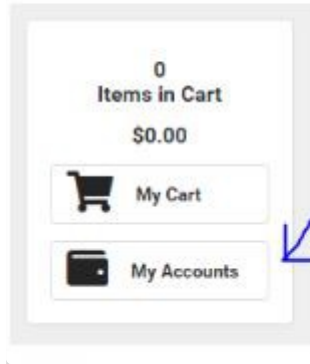
The Spring Play, Shakespeare's *Twelfth Night*, will be presented on February 20-22 at 7:00 pm in the Performing Arts Center.
