ACT ASPIRE Testing

The **ACT Aspire** will be given to students in grades 9 and 10 at Stoughton High School on **Tuesday, April 21, 2020**. The ACT Aspire is a standardized test designed to evaluate and report on student learning and college and career readiness. The ACT Aspire Early High School assessment measures what students have learned in the areas of English, reading, math, science, and writing. The scores from this assessment predict how a student will perform on the ACT in 11th grade.

Students in grades 11 and 12 will not attend school on this day. Students in grades 9 and 10 should arrive at their regular time but maybe finished with testing and allowed to leave school by 3 pm. Busses will run on the normal schedule.

Follow the directions of the website to schedule your testing. Placement testing must be done prior to scheduling registration/orientation sessions this spring.

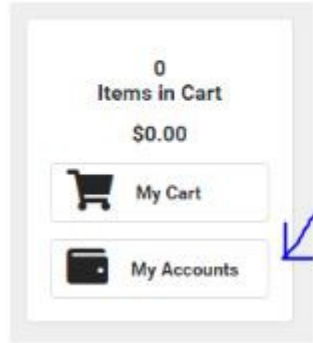

This is a firm deadline. Please do not forget to order your Yearbook.

Order your yearbooks today! Your 2020 yearbook is just a few clicks away!
First, log on to your Infinite Campus Portal.
Second, click on the My Accounts icon.



Next, you will see these options. Click on the Optional Payments box.

The next screen will show a list of payments. Find the Yearbook-HS option and add it to your cart. Once it is in the cart you can apply a payment with a credit or debit card and you are done!
