SCHEDULE FOR VIRTUAL LEARNING

All students will have the same morning start times for lessons:

8:00

9:30

10:45

Each morning, the homeroom class will start with a Morning Meeting and then begin their instruction. Depending on the grade level, lessons may not take the full time scheduled as we start the year.

In the afternoon, schedules will vary based on the needs of the students. Teachers will be getting to know students in the afternoons for the first two weeks with individual or small group zoom meetings. We will not have Music, Art, PE, Library or Counseling lessons during the first week. Those lessons will start the week of 9/8.

Live, synchronous instruction opt-out

Dear Parents and Guardians,

In light of the District starting the year with remote instruction, our District will be communicating electronically with parents and using electronic means and virtual/online platforms to facilitate the provision of educational services. To manage learning, students will use the following platforms:

Grades K-2 Seesaw

Grades 3-5 Google Classroom

Grades 6-12 Schoology

To that end, your child's teacher will provide virtual lessons and/or discussions via Zoom.

Tacchere will use 700m to held experience live instruction with students, including both full

classroom, small group, and (potentially) 1:1 meetings. Teachers will directly invite students to a password-protected video conference through a district-managed application. Students will accept the invite through their district-managed Google account. This is a direct connection and no additional log-in is required if students are already logged into their accounts. The video classroom is for school managed activities only. It will be the responsibility of the teacher to disconnect the video session once the lesson or check-in has been completed. Students should be located in a quiet environment that is free from distractions or items which may not conform to school rules and *guidelines*. Students must also wear clothing that conforms to the District's dress code, and comply with all other aspects of the District's Code of Conduct. To promote confidentiality of student information, your student should not include other children or adults in your household in the lesson or meeting.

One change from last year is that synchronous live learning will be recorded, and posted to your student(s) learning management system. Recording lessons will help keep students engaged in their class work, and allow for students to review previous lessons at a later time. All recorded lessons will be stored in district approved applications and learning management systems (SeeSaw, Google Classroom, or Schoology, depending on grade level) and will require a student account to access.

If you **do not** consent for your child to participate in recorded, synchronous live instruction, and/or you do not give permission for your child to participate in possible live, small group instruction that is not recorded, please let us know by filling out this electronic form *linked here*.

TEACHING AND LEARNING


We will continue to provide rigorous, grade-level academic content to all students while also working to fill in any unfinished learning from last year. To do this:

- Grade levels have departmentalized instruction, which means 1 teacher will be primarily
 responsible for teaching Math (Bridges), 1 teacher will be teaching English Language Arts
 (Wit and Wisdom), and 1 teacher will be teaching phonics, handwriting and science/social
 studies. All students will still continue to have an assigned homeroom teacher.
- In the morning we will offer: synchronous (live) core instruction (English Language Arts,
 Phonics Bridges). Core lessons will be recorded and posted for students who are unable.

to attend live instruction.

- In the afternoon we will offer:
 - Specialist lessons in PE/ART/Music
 - Enrichment opportunities will also be offered including edutyping, EpicBooks,
 Recorded ReadAlouds, Dreambox and additive math practice with Bridges learning apps.
 - Synchronous (live) Intervention will be offered in the afternoon for students needing additional support.
- Please note: Times for synchronous (live) instruction will be the same across all three
 elementary buildings. We also are working to ensure that each zoom has multiple staff
 supporting the instruction.
- **Grading:** We are still working on grading guidance for the upcoming school year. Stay tuned.

ATTENDANCE PROCEDURE

Attendance will be taken daily at the elementary level. Teachers will take attendance during each of the synchronous (live) instructional sessions, and will look for work activity at the end of the school day.
