School Pictures are COMING SOON!!!

Great news!! We have scheduled school picture times for all grade levels during the month of March. Taking school photos will allow you to order portraits if you have not already done so and will ensure your student is in their school yearbook. Given our tight timelines for yearbooks, there will be NO RETAKE days.

Picture Procedures

Please review the following picture procedures, which were developed with safety as our top priority.

Families must:

- Sign-up is required for all, EXCEPT Hybrid Vikings in grades 6-8.
- Arrive no more than 5 minutes before your scheduled picture time.
- Grades K-5: Bring only one parent per household and only students in grades K-5.
- Grades 6-12: Only students receiving pictures should enter the building. Enter the building without parents and/or siblings not receiving pictures.
- Adhere to district COVID-19 protocol found <u>here</u>, including wearing masks and self-screening for symptoms of COVID-19 before entering the building.

Upon entering the building, please visit the check-in station for the next steps. When it is your turn, present your child's ID card (grades K-5) to the photographer OR state your student ID (grades 6-12). Students may remove their mask briefly for pictures but must immediately put it back on.

Because school pictures will be running on a tight schedule, please make every effort to order pictures <u>online</u>.
