HERB KOHL FOUNDATION TEACHER AND PRINCIPAL NOMINATIONS CAN NOW BE SUBMITTED ONLINE

Nominations of Wisconsin PK through 12 teachers and principals can now be submitted online at www.kohleducation.org for the 2022 Herb Kohl Educational Foundation Teacher Fellowship and Principal Leadership awards. The deadline for submission is Tuesday, October 12, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. central time. Awards are \$6,000, with an additional \$6,000 grant going to the school of each selected teacher and principal. Established in 1990, the Herb Kohl Educational Foundation awards 100 Fellowships and 16 Leadership awards annually from among all applicants throughout the state. For teachers or principals to be eligible, they must be nominated by a parent, student, other teachers, community member, or school administrator. Wisconsin teachers and principals in grades PK through 12 who plan to continue in their current capacity for at least one year are eligible. The Herb Kohl Educational Foundation Fellowship rewards teachers who have demonstrated superior ability to inspire the love of learning in their students, have motivated others, and have provided meritorious service both in and outside the classroom. It also recognizes and supports principals who demonstrate administrative leadership and positively influence school culture.

Online nominations must be submitted at www.kohleducation.org by Tuesday, October 12, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. central time. Selection of recipients will be made by a state-level panel composed of representatives from the Wisconsin Newspaper Association Foundation, Association of Wisconsin School Administrators, cooperative educational service agencies, several education-related associations, and community representatives. Since the program was established in 1990, the Herb Kohl Foundation has awarded 3,313 grants to teachers and principals, and 3,313 matching grants to their schools throughout the state for a total of \$13,396,000.

The Herb Kohl Educational Foundation Fellowship and Leadership programs are co-sponsored by the Wisconsin Newspaper Association Foundation, Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, Association of Wisconsin School Administrators, and the state's 12 cooperative educational service agencies.

Do you need help filling out the FAFSA?

You can get **free** help completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at College Goal Wisconsin. Financial aid professionals and other educators volunteer at the event to help students and their families complete the FAFSA. Anyone who is planning to pursue post-secondary education in the 2022-23 academic year should complete the FAFSA. That includes high school seniors, continuing college students, transfer students, and adult students considering pursuing higher education. The FAFSA is the form that must be submitted to be considered for federal and state financial aid including grants and loans. In addition to getting professional help completing the FAFSA, attendees will have the opportunity to enter a scholarship drawing.

Nurtured Heart Approach

THE most powerful action that you can do to support your child (or others you interact with) in learning self-regulation, building stronger relationships, and understanding their greatness is to lean into 3-second noticings over...and over...and over again.

I saw you for like .. 3 seconds. And it made my day.

Say out loud all the things that you see them doing all the time, 3-seconds at a time.

- "I saw you put the dishes in the washer. Thank you."
- "I heard you singing. It was beautiful!"
- "I noticed you stopped to calm yourself before you answered me."
- "I appreciated your help getting out the door this morning."
- "You are always so helpful with (insert pet's name). Thank you."

Set yourself a goal of 5 noticings an hour to start. That's only a 15-second commitment per hour! It's these little intentional interactions that make the biggest impact. It's so simple and yet so hard.
