Meal Program Changes effective January 21

Action is required of any family who wishes for their child to receive school meals in any capacity.

Dear SASD families,

Our district is able to continue serving free meals through the end of the 2020-21 school year, thanks to the USDA and National School Lunch Program.

The district is proud of and grateful to all of our staff who have supported the door-to-door meal delivery program. As we transition more grade levels back to in-person learning, we will no longer be able to support our current door-to-door meal delivery. Our final door-to-door meal delivery will be on Tuesday, January 19 and our first onsite meal pick up will be on January 21. Meal options by grade level are below. Please review for program description and next steps for your child.

Onsite meal pickup will be Thursday evenings at Sandhill Elementary (1620 Lincoln Avenue) from 4:45pm - 6:15 pm. Sign up is required. If you wish to participate in our onsite meal pick up on day 1 (January 21), **you must submit your request by Wednesday, January 13.** Sign ups after this date will receive a confirmation email from Jenny McKenna within 48 business hours.

Virtual Vikings Grades K-12 AND children not yet in school may participate in weekly onsite meal pick up

- Onsite pick up will include breakfast and lunch for 7 days

- Students currently receiving meals at home WILL NOT automatically transfer to the new pick up process and will need to [SIGN UP HERE](#).

In-Person Vikings Grades K-2 may participate in daily school meals

- Students currently receiving meals will continue receiving meals daily; They will also continue to receive a Friday grab and go bag including meals for Saturday and Sunday. Students must take breakfast and lunch.
- If you are not receiving meals at school and would like to, you will need to [SIGN UP HERE](#).

Hybrid Vikings Grades 3-5 may participate in onsite meal pick up for virtual instruction days and daily lunch at school for in-person instruction days. Students who sign up commit to eating while in person AND onsite pick up for non-in person days on Thursday. It is currently not an option to select lunch for just in-person instruction days.

- Onsite pick up will include lunch for virtual instruction days and breakfast for all 7 days
- Each student will receive lunch at school on in-person instruction days.
- Breakfast will not be served at school
- Students currently receiving meals at home WILL NOT automatically transfer over to the new meal process and will need to [SIGN UP HERE](#).

Hybrid Vikings Grades 6-12 may participate in option 1 and/or option 2.

- Option 1- Onsite pick up will include lunch for the days they attend virtual instruction and breakfast for all 7 days. Students must **[SIGN UP HERE](#)**.
- Option 2 - Daily onsite lunch for in-person instruction days. Sign up is not required. Any in-person student may receive lunch any day they are present.
- Breakfast WILL NOT be served in the building for option 2.
- Students currently receiving meals at home WILL NOT automatically transfer over to the new meal program model and will need to [SIGN UP HERE](#).
