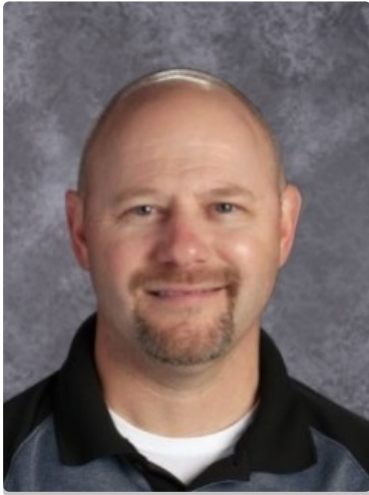

ACT Testing-March 8 for 11th grade only. Grades 9, 10, 12 will learn virtually on that date.

ASPIRE Testing-April 19 for 9th and 10th grades. Grades 11, 12 will be learning virtually on that date.

Additional information will be provided at the beginning of the 2nd semester.

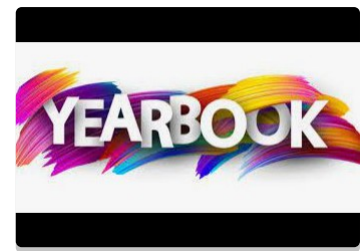
