Academic and Career Planning (ACP)

Academic and Career Planning is a student-driven process where students explore and make informed decisions about their future. All students in grades 6-12 throughout Wisconsin are provided academic and career development activities. Eighth Grade Academic and Career Planning Conferences are a part of Academic and Career Planning.
