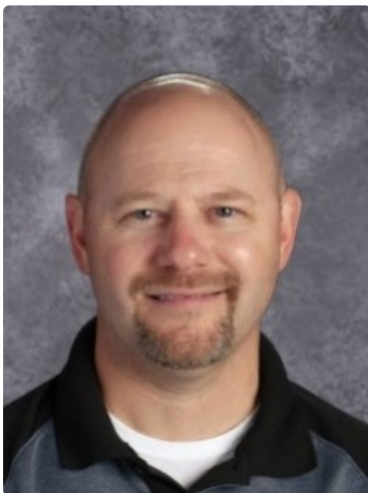

Virtual Students, email staci.heimsoth@Stoughton.k12.wi.us to set up a before school time to learn the dances.

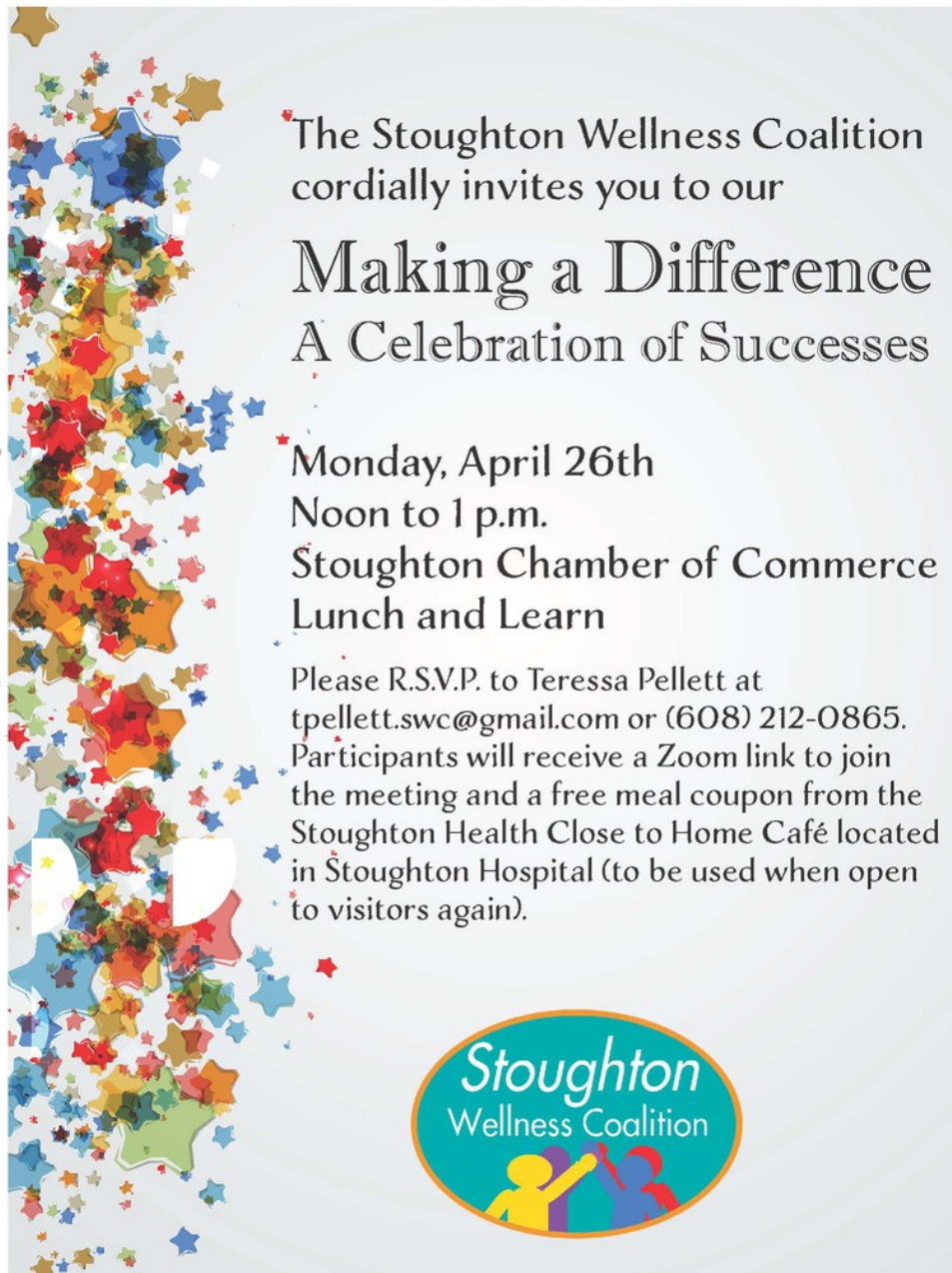
Students interested in trying out to be a keyboardist or violin player, please also come during your lunch time to get more information!!
