- New Second Step Social and Emotional Curriculum

We are pleased to share with you that this improvement work resulted in many positive outcomes at River Bluff for the 2018-19 school year including:





- 23 % reduction in office discipline referrals, and
- A 5% spring to spring increase in STAR Literacy scores for every grade.

River Bluff takes great pride in creating a school where students can learn in a caring and creative environment. Together our staff encourages students to engage in many ways of learning, and in the most personalized ways possible. We look to forward this year to continue to build on last year's efforts and continuously improve our student climate and student achievement in math and literacy. Our teachers will regularly collaborate, analyze data, plan instruction, and develop common assessments to ensure student achievement is attained throughout each grade level.

PBIS Kick-Off

River Bluff uses a well-researched system to improve overall school climate and individual behavior. This system is called PBIS or Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports. Our focus is to explicitly teach behavioral expectations and then recognize the positive behaviors shown by students. Students can earn CREW tickets by doing the right thing, which can be turned in to their teachers for special rewards. Teaching behavioral expectations and rewarding students for following them is a much more positive approach than waiting for misbehavior to occur before responding.

Our building also puts on fun events for students to attend, to increase their engagement with school and the positive climate here. For instance, River Bluff students ended their first week of school by having a PBIS Kick-off Day. This day involved interactive lessons, so all students could learn how to act at River Bluff following the CREW Way. "Choose to be, Respectful of All, engaged in Safety, and Willingly accept responsibility."

STAR Testing Begins Next Week

Please be aware that STAR testing will take place next week. We will be completing the reading test on Monday in Integrated Studies classes and the math test on Tuesday in math classes. Students should bring ear buds on math testing days)TUESDAY unless they are absent that day) so they have the option to hear the portions of the test read aloud.

This is the first of 3 screening windows, designed to monitor student progress. Please help your child do the best they can by ensuring they get adequate sleep and a good breakfast on testing days! We will notify you when results will be available in Infinite Campus, and teachers will share additional information at Parent Teacher conferences.

Student Chromebook Distribution

We distributed student Chromebooks at River Bluff last Thursday, September 5th. When students bring their Chromebook home, it will be important to establish a routine to charge their Chromebook each night so it is fully charged the next day. Football Game Expectations for Middle School Students

In preparation for future football games at Stoughton High School, we will continue to take steps to ensure safety at the games and present a more polished look of our community. Please take the time to share this information with the appropriate students of SASD Elementary and River Bluff Middle School to prepare them for the football season. Key items are that: RBMS students will continue to have their own seating section, elementary students are to be accompanied by an adult and information



regarding behavior expectations. Thank you in advance of your cooperation and positive promotion of the Stoughton community.

Football Game Expectations for Middle/Elementary School Students Middle School Section: (Location)

All students will be on the North (home) side of Collins Field Located East of the Pressbox...on the hilltop behind main grandstand Students without parent/guardian escort are expected to enter Collins Field through the East (Community) gate

Behavior expectations:

- Be a spectator, be respectful of the game, fans and staff
- Seated on bleachers and/or tables or stand on the grass area provided
- Promote positive cheer support for the Stoughton Vikings "We are Stoughton"
- No footballs, soccer balls, etc. or games in general are not acceptable
- Running, tag games, wrestling, etc. are also not acceptable
- RBMS students without parent/guardians must use MS student section for supervision
- Students with parent/guardians are permitted to sit with parents, but are not allowed wandering throughout Collins Field

Benefits:

Students will have a designated area on home sideline that will have designated MS seating Students can see the scoreboard, have access to concessions and a better connection of the game as being part of the home crowd

Promotes a more polished public image of the Stoughton Community and provides safety of our students

Tech Reminders

Schoology Learning Management System

In support of our digital learning plan, we implemented a district learning management system called Schoology. Schoology empowers our educators to integrate a more paperless learning environment where all students have an opportunity to extend their learning beyond the regular school day. New this year, all families will have access to their student's digital classroom through Schoology. Be on the lookout for an email from Schoology for more information on how to access your parent Schoology account.

Securly Filtering

The district uses Securly to filter student Chromebooks while students are at school and home. Securly provides families access to their students online activity at home. Families have an option to add additional internet filters while students use their district Chromebook at home. If you are new to River Bluff, you will receive an email from Securly as the start of school approaches providing information on how to access your parent Securly account. After your account is created, you will receive a weekly digest that will contain browsing history and websites that have been blocked by our filters.

Infinite Campus

The district utilizes Infinite Campus for many processes such as attendance, food service, field trips and other fees. Infinite Campus has alert features that can be set to help support your family's connection to the information and for academic notifications. These features can be set by using the computer version of the program. At the middle school, grades and report cards are also sent out to families via Infinite Campus.
